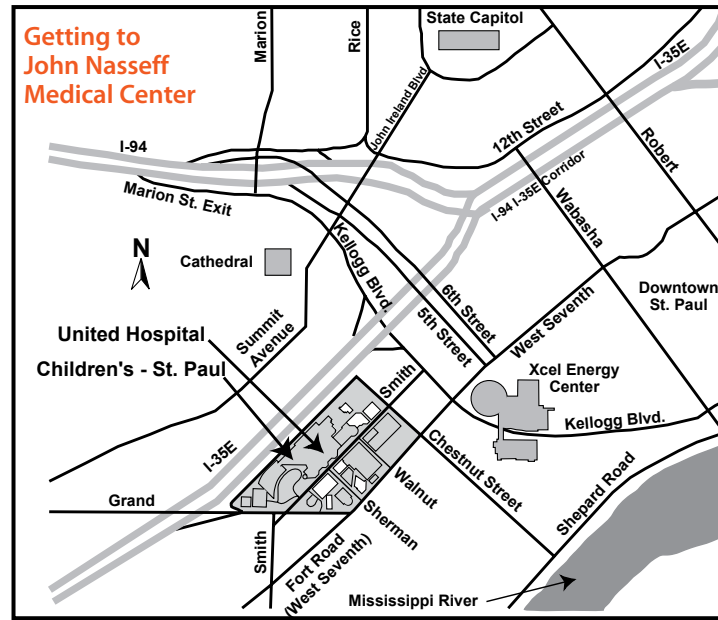

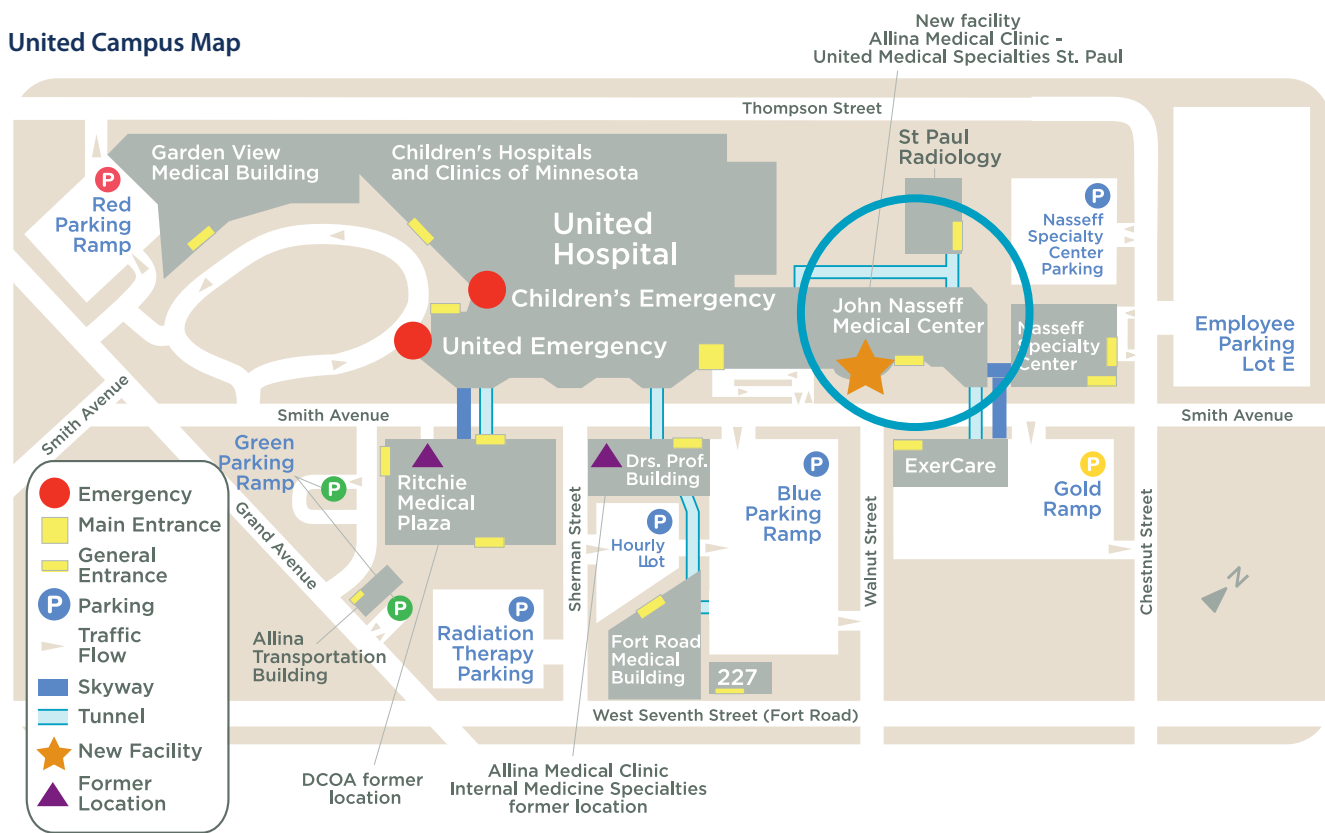

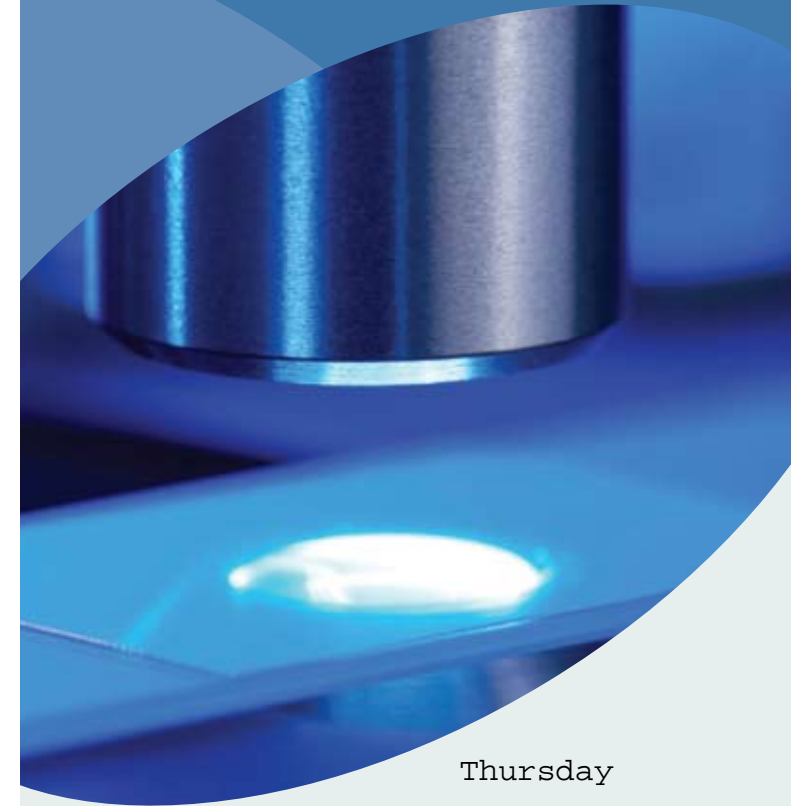
United Campus Map

The presentation will describe the role of sudden unexpected death in the natural history of metabolic disorders, especially mitochondrial fatty acid oxidation disorders. It will include an overview of available methods to perform a “metabolic autopsy” but also underscore the impact that newborn screening has had in recent years toward prevention of morbidity and mortality in childhood and even later in life.

- Learn how to secure suitable specimens for postmortem evaluation of a sudden death case
- Understand the current status of newborn screening in Minnesota and elsewhere in the US
