Please accept our apologies for any recent confusion regarding the Vitamin D, 25- Hydroxy testing. There were issues with our regular referral lab, Quest Diagnostics, and until they were resolved we needed to send the testing to Mayo Medical Laboratories. We regret that we did not inform our clients that in order to accomplish this move to Mayo Medical Laboratories, we would be cancelling the ordered test and reordering it as an MSO.

As of September 18th, these issues have been resolved and we will once again be sending the Vitamin D 25 Hydroxy test to Quest. You may still see some going to Mayo but be assured all ordered Vitamin D testing will be completed.

In the future, there will be additional changes to this test - the Vitamin D, 25-Hydroxy will include three separate results; a Vitamin D2, a Vitamin D3 and a Total Vitamin D. We will send notification to you when these changes take place.
